NACMA Trade Rules, Contracts & Dispute Resolution

Course content

Participants will receive practical hands on training in the following subject areas.

1. The Australian grain supply chain and the appropriate contracts for each sector.
2. Interpretation of the Trade Rules – placing the Trade Rules into a commercial context.
3. Dispute Resolution – methods, process and legal authority. NACMA arbitrations have been challenged at Supreme Court level and have been upheld.

Length

One day - for experienced industry personnel who are using the trade rules and contracts in their work environment on a daily basis. The one course is essentially an update course.

Two days – designed of those who require a greater understanding of the background. Ideal for junior traders/traders assistants/back office staff.

- Extensive written reference material including current Trade Rules, contracts and Dispute Resolution Rules.
- Morning & afternoon tea
- Lunch

Recognition of Prior Learning

Current industry personnel who wish to satisfy the assessment for any of the subjects leading to the Professional Certificate are able to sit for the assessment without attending the workshops.

Assessment

Assessment is offered on all core subjects and is designed to replicate workplace conditions. There will be a mix of assignments and practical assessments that are designed to test a candidate's ability to conduct the activities in a work environment. All assessments will be open book. The cost for assessment is \$150 per subject.
